- 1. The listing cycle for the 2026 Integrated Report is currently open and ends October 21, 2022. The solicitation notice can be found on the <u>Surface Water Quality Assessment</u> website. The current cycle focuses on surface waterbodies such as rivers, streams, lakes, reservoirs, estuaries, lagoons, bays, and ocean waters in the following areas of California:
 - The regions of the North Coast, Lahontan, and Colorado River Basin Regional Water Boards.
 - The San Joaquin River sub-area of the Central Valley Regional Water Board, which is defined as the San Joaquin River watershed and includes the mainstem of the San Joaquin River upstream of the legal boundary of the Sacramento-San Joaquin Delta and all surface waters tributary to the mainstem.
- 2. The group continued the discussion on passive sampler entry. While the group had previously used mass of analyte per sorbent in the draft guidance document, one member reiterated that this unit is harder to provide because the lab reports results in mass of analyte per mass of sorbent. Further, labs developed specific methods for passive sampler analysis. Others didn't think this was appropriate for liquid sorbents. Those with passive sampler analysis lab reports were encouraged to send examples to <u>Jarma Bennett</u>.
