	Notes WQX Project – The flow between CEDEN and EPA's STORET system through the Water Quality Exchange (WQX) is now in production.
	Lookup Lists – During the January meeting, a few modifications to the Lookup List areas of the CEDEN website. Accordingly, the CAS number has been added to the table in the analyte search result screen. The last updated date is available per value in both the search screen results screen and the list of values per list, both on screen and in the Excel download.
2	Fates of Systems – After the January meeting, a user group member asked if the Water Boards had intentions to retire either the California Integrated Water Quality System (CIWQS) or CEDEN because of the connections being made to other systems. The Water Board intends to keep both of these systems, but the topic did spawn questions about regulatory compliance and which system data should be used for submitting data. Jarma will work with those members that posed the questions during the meeting and with Regional Board staff to ensure that permits are consistent with the messages that are being delivered through the CEDEN User Group.

4	Matrices Available Through Query Tool The main purpose of CEDEN is to capture ambient surface water data and make it available. Currently there are data associated to matrices that do not represent ambient surface water, such as "runoff" and "effluent." Should the query tool be revised so that data associated with the following matrices are not available: air, effluent, runoff, overlying water, and PBSwater (phosphate buffered saline)? Or should it be left as is and let the user select the desired options.
	Notes During the meeting, several participants voiced their opinion that users should have the option of what is queried so no changes should be made to the query tool. Therefore, no changes will be made in this regard.
