4	<p><u>Updates</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ <i>Tissue query fix</i> ➤ <i>QAPPs needed</i> <p><u>Notes:</u> The CEDEN Advanced Query Tool (AQT) for tissue data was modified in October so that the number of fish per composite is accurately displayed in the output.</p> <p>Quality Assurance Project Plans (QAPPs) are required to accompany data in order for those surface water data to be used as part of the Clean Water Act Section 303(d) listing process. Subsequent to the meeting, an email was sent to the CEDEN Lyris list and CEDEN User Group requesting QAPPs for otherwise eligible projects.</p>
